Descripción: Training course will be focus on the theme of marine bio-acoustic technology and positively transfer the frontier knowledge on marine bio-acoustic technology to other developing countries in the way of combining lectures and field trips to improve the participants' practical application capacity so as to help other developing countries operate marine research and development as well as foster talent pool force. Training course covers contents of fundamental theory of marine bio-acoustic technology, its application of marine fisheries, etc. and lectures including Introduction to Chinese National Situation, Economy, Trade and Cultural Custom, etc, Introduction to Marine Bioacoustics Technology, Application of Sonar Technology in Marine Fishery, Ocean Noise and its Potential Impacts on Marine Mammals, Fisheries Acoustics Theory and Practice, etc. will be arranged during the training. The lecturers are scholars and experts who come from Fujian Institute of Oceanography, Xiamen University, Xiamen Municipal Bureau of Commerce, Oceans & Fisheries Bureau of Xiamen, Quanzhou Oceanic and Fishery Bureau, etc. In addition, we will organize participants to visit and communicate with Key Laboratory of Underwater Acoustic Communication and Marine Information Technology (Xiamen University), Ministry of Education.

Besides, participants will be organized to visit scenic spots of Gulang Island of Xiamen and Wuyi mountain which enjoys the reputation of the world cultural and natural heritage, Quanzhou City (the starting point of Maritime Silk Road) and Capital Beijing, etc. in order to have more comprehensive understanding of China after its reform and opening up and the hospitable Chinese people.
