- Be good in Health, both phisically and mentally
- Have not previously recieved a scholarship from the Korean government
- A participant who has once whitdrawn from the program due to a failure to attain certain grades, a violation of these rules of the training institute, or a false entry is not allowed to re-apply for scholarship programm.

Course-Specific Criteria

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection procedure will include two rounds: an interview by the Korean embassy or KOICA office and an evaluation of the application package in Round 1, and a thelephone interview by the University in round 2

1) 1st Round : On-site interview by the Korean embassy or KOICA office and an evaluation of the application package

The Korean embassy or KOICA office will counduct and interview for each applicant. Based on the result of the interview and the evaluation of application package by the university, the university will select applicants for de 2nd round.

2) 2nd round: Telephone interview by the university Interviews will be counducted only for those who have passed the first round, and the Embassy/Koica. The interview will be conducted in the KOICA office or the Korean Embassy. The candidates will pass the identification process before having the interview.
