■ **1950 - 2050: A century of Energy REvolution - understanding the transition of energy systems**

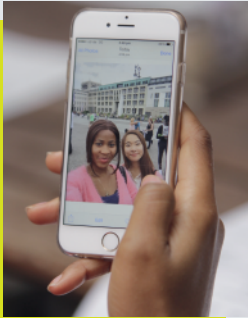
Explore the changing nature of energy systems and take field trips to observe different approaches in action.
